Registration Information: Please read through this document and see [Steps 1-5](#) on the next 2 pages to register.

Registration Timeline: In order for us to plan, it is **VERY** important to register **at least 30 days in advance**. Space is limited & based on a first come, first serve basis. Classes are expected to fill however if the minimum numbers are not met 21 days prior, the course(s) may be rescheduled or cancelled.

Registration Fees: Full payment is due at time of registration to confirm your space, however will not be processed or if paid by check, deposited until *30 days prior to the start of the program (*cancellation penalties start at 30 days out - see below)

Eligibility: Participants must be at least the age of majority and hold full time employment working in and around trees as an arborist, in a hands-on role supporting arborists, or other related role in which you use arborist equipment on a regular basis. Courses not offered to individuals who do not work in an arborist or supporting arborist capacity nor private homeowners or for recreational tree climbing purposes.

Cancel Policy: Up to 30 days: Full refund; 29-15 days: 50% penalty; 14-0 days: 100% cancel penalty; No-shows: No refund.

Release: Participants are required to sign a release form on the first day of each class. Upon receipt of your registration, a participant release form will be sent to you (*see text below*). Cancellation rules apply, and refusal to sign a release form on Day 1 may result in your forfeiting all or part of your registration fee, unless you cancel your course(s) at least 30 days in advance.

Student Gear List: What to bring to class

ArborMaster L1 Tree Climbing Methods, Work Positioning & Best Practice

If you do not have personal climbing equipment, *we recommend you attend the course before purchasing new equipment.* We will have some equipment on hand for students to try out and share amongst themselves. This will provide you with an opportunity to make better decisions buying equipment post course.

It is **required** that students bring their own Personal Protective Equipment as outlined below.

Required: Personal Protective Equipment:

- Helmet/Hard hat
- Eye & ear protection
- Climbing boots/Work boots (see below)

Recommended: Personal Protective Equipment:

- Ear protection
- Work gloves (sticky or grippy gloves, rubber or nubbed fingers & palms)
- Work boots: that provide good ankle support

Personal Gear: (not required, however please bring these items if you have them)

You are encouraged to bring equipment you own and also equipment you use that you would like to discuss with the instructor. With that said, please see this next section:

- Climbing harness/saddle
- Arborist Climbing Line
- Work Positioning Lanyard
- Climbing spurs (spikes)
- Pruning hand saw
- Throw line (Students will receive a new throwline and 2 shout pouches)

- Other climbing equipment you use

- Classes will take place rain or shine. We suggest that before departing for your program, that you check the extended forecast for the area that the training will be held. If rain is at all forecasted, we strongly recommend that you bring appropriate rain gear, thermal undergarments if in a colder climate and a change of clothing on the day of the class
